1.0 Welcome and Roll Call

*Meeting called to order by Alexis Kovalovich at 4:00 p.m.

2.0 Old Items

- 2.1 Vacant Positions/Filled Positions: Ms. Harbin gave an update of staffing: The GATE teacher is now officially in the Humanities (Formerly the Art classroom). She explained that we are currently in the process of setting up interviews for the Early Childhood and Library teaching positions as well as some of our support staff positions.
- 2.2 Humanities/Science: Ms. Harbin explained that Ms. Duran is now officially in the Humanities position which will emphasize science.
- 2.3 Distance Learning: Ms. Harbin stated the distance learning is ongoing and that teachers will continue to educate students virtually until the end of the school year.

3.0 New Items

- 3.1 Revised Budget...Amendment to SP178: Ms. Harbin explained that the funds which had been unused due to the school closures were originally going to go back to the state. However, the District then informed principals that they could spend the money but were given a short turnaround to submit the amendment. Therefore, the majority of the money, after paying the current CTT for the remainder of the school year, would be spent on technology as delineated below:
 - 3.1.1 54,489.07-7,000 CTT...Balance 47,489.07
 - 3.1.2 Black Mouse 152...\$834.48
 - 3.1.3 Laptops 7...\$4,151.00
 - 3.1.4 Chromebook carts 4...4,200.00

There was no discussion and all members were in agreement with the expenditures listed.

- 3.2 Beautification Rocky/MP Room...Ms. Harbin explained that the project to updated the Rocky logo above the stage had been completed.
- 3.3 ESY- Distance Learning: Ms. Harbin explained that Aggie Roberts would be a site for the Extended School Year for designated students with IEPs, however the learning would take place virtually this year.
- 3.4 School Closure-Student Deployment of Personal Items... Ms. Harbin explained that details regarding when students will be able to pick up their materials such as yearbooks are still to be determined based on the Governor and school district's timelines.
